ACADEMICS, TRAINING AND LEADERSHIP

1. **Board Results.** 100% success in CBSE in Class X and XII with maximum cadets obtaining distinction.
2. **NDA Performance.** Maximum cadets should clear the UPSC written exam in the first attempt and should make best efforts to clear the SSB.
3. **Counseling.** Look into the Psychological aspects of the cadet through specialized counseling to ensure stress free environment to the cadet.
4. **Games and Sports.** Provide modern infrastructure and quality training to the cadets in various outdoor games to enable participation in South Zone and various National level championships like Subroto Cup.
5. **Extra Co-curricular Activities.** Provide a wide platform to the cadets to participate and excel in various extra co-curricular activities at the Inter House, Zonal and National Levels.
6. **Clubs.** Provide variety of clubs to the cadets to choose as per his hobby and interest.
7. **Communication and Personality Development.** Adopt methodologies such as talk in assembly, debates, group discussions, lecturettes, spell bee etc. to develop cadets knowledge and communication skills. Organize guest lectures, Personality Development programmes, Excursions, visit to academies and participation in camps to ensure overall personality development.
8. **Officer Like Quality.** Ensure every aspect of the training schedule has an OLQ inbuilt in it. Train the cadets to become future leaders who can shoulder responsibilities confidently.
9. **Faculty Enrichment Programme.** Enrichment of Teachers through various in-house and CBSE enrichment programmes.



10. **NCC.** Every cadet of Sainik School Korukonda is enrolled in NCC. Cadets are trained on drill movements, parade, Guard of Honour in addition to imparting subject knowledge on NCC prescribed syllabus. Camps and exams are conducted every year for obtaining A and B certificates during their stay in the school.

ADMINISTRATION

11. Provide modern classrooms with updated educational software, auditorium, audio visual room, laboratories, language lab, Atal Tinkering lab, Motivation Hall and Museum for academic development of a cadet and motivation to join the Defence Forces.
12. Provide state of the art sports facilities viz Synthetic courts, Swimming Pool, Indoor Sports Complex, Horse Riding facility to the cadets.
13. **School Website and ERP.** Provide a robust school website with all necessary information and links for the benefit of cadets, parents, alumni and other viewers. The school ERP provides necessary automation between various departments of academic block, administrative block, cadet mess, MI Room, CSD, clothing and book stores and various ancillaries. The ERP also provides online fee payment facility to the parents.
14. **Cadet Mess.** The school runs an automated cadet mess which can accommodate 650 cadets. The school maintains quality crockery and cutlery. The staff dines in with the cadets to inculcate table manners and OLQs.
15. **MI Room.** The school has a 12 bedded hospital with resident doctor, male and female nursing assistant. The school also has modern medical equipment and an ambulance.



16. **Houses.** The school provides 09 x 72 bedded hostels for accommodating the cadets. The hostels are equipped with study rooms, furniture, Wi Fi connectivity, 02 x Computers, TV, recreational and telephone facilities. The house masters are housed within the house block and each house is under CCTV surveillance.

17. **Ragging Free Campus.** The school campus viz; academic block, classrooms and hostels are under CCTV surveillance. Anti-Ragging Boards are displayed at various places. Undertaking obtained from all cadets and parents informing strict disciplinary actions as per the law promulgated by Supreme Court of India.
18. **Accommodation.** The school provides 100% accommodation to the cadets and staff within the campus.
19. **Facilities.** The school has a dairy farm which caters for milk, butter and other dairy products for the cadet mess and the staff. The school also has agricultural farm which partially meets the requirements of fruits and vegetables. The school laundry provides laundry services to the cadets and staff.
20. **Cadets Amenity Centre.** It provides the CSD, barber shop, tailor shop and tuck shop facilities to the cadets.



KNOW YOUR SCHOOL

1. Sainik School, Korukonda was established at the behest of Shri Jawaharlal Nehru, Nation's first Prime Minister and Shri VK Krishna Menon, the then Defence Minister.

2. Sainik School Korukonda is situated 12 kilometers away from Vizianagaram, Andhra Pradesh, India. Sainik School Korukonda is one amongst the 33 Sainik Schools which prepares boys and girls academically, physically and mentally to join National Defence Academy / Indian Naval Academy. The Alak Appala Kondayamba Vijayaram Palace at Korukonda where the journey of this premier educational institute commenced is a solid tribute to the great service to the cause of education and philanthropic glory of the Royal Family of Vizianagaram. The Korukonda Palace was built in 1911 by Maharaja Vijayaram Gajapathi Raju as his country residency. The Korukonda Palace was gifted for the purpose of running a Sainik School by Smt. Bhagirathi Devi garu with the consent of her husband "Sir Vizzy" in Sep 1961. The prime mover of the gift was the great philanthropist and educationist Dr. PVG Raju, Raja Saheb of Vizianagaram and the nephew of Sir Vizzy. As a rich tribute to the philanthropic gesture of the Royal Family, the original crest and motto of the Gajapathis was adopted by the school right from its inception and the Central Hall of the Royal Korukonda Palace, too, has been named after Maharani Lalita Kumari Devi, the mother of Sir Vizzy.

3. Sainik School Korukonda was formally raised by Cdr Trevor De Almeida, the 1st Principal of the School on 18 Jan 1962. Maj AP Ganguli was the first Head Master and Lt Cdr A F Crastowas the first Registrar of the school. The first batch of the school commenced with a strength of 205 cadets, 11 academic staff and a set of admin staff. On the historic day of 22 Jan 1962 the journey began with the address by the Principal during the first assembly in the palace hall.

4. The school, spread over sprawling area of 205.20 acres has a beautiful campus with well-laid out roads and buildings. The instructional block of the school is a two storied building with classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, an art and craft gallery and various academic departments. The administrative wing of the school is housed in the Maharaja's Palace. The School started off with four Houses in 1962 and today it has nine houses namely, Pallava



House, Kakatiya, Maurya, Pandiya, Gajapathi, Chalukya, Moghul and Gupta House for the Boys and Satavahana House for the Girl cadets. The school dining hall named after the First Principal, Cdr Trevor De Almeida can accommodate 650 cadets for dinning at a time. The school has a full-fledged sports ground which facilitates all sports and infrastructure for conduct of PT, Games and Parade. Indoor Sports Complex comprising of indoor basketball, badminton, table tennis along with indoor shooting range and Gymnasium was gifted by the Old Boys in 2012 during the Golden Jubilee. With the support of the old boys and funds received from the State and Centre, various other infrastructural developments came up over the period of years. The Academic Block came up in 1976, Mali Mastan Babu Swimming Pool in 1991, PVG Auditorium in 1995, War Memorial in 2001, Squash Court in 2002, RO Plant in 2007, Art/Craft Room in 2008, Library in 2009, Horse Stable and Community Hall in 2016, New Gupta House and ATL Lab in 2019, Cadets Amenity Centre in 2020, Motivational Hall in 2021 and Saikor Museum and Parents Lounge in 2022. The School also houses military artifacts installed at various places to motivate the cadets.

5. Over the span of 60 years of its journey, 5476 cadets have passed out from the school out of which more than 700 cadets have entered into National Defence Academy and Indian Naval Academy. The school also lauds to its credit of bagging the Raksha Mantri's trophy during the years 1977, 1980, 2001 and 2015 for having sent maximum no of cadets to National Defence Academy and Indian Naval Academy.

6. The School has very strong alumni called 'Saikorians'. With the motto of 'Together for Ever', the 'Saikor' family has been extensively contributing to the growth and welfare of the cadets of the school through various projects.

7. The school having completed 60 years of service is proudly marching ahead with strength of 570 cadets including the newly inducted girl cadets, lead by a team of three service officers, groomed by 26 academic staff and looked after by 22 administrative staff and 52 General Employees. The School now ranks as one of the best schools in the Country.



SCHOOL COLOUR

The maroon colour of the school flag denotes the red colour of the Army and the grey colour denotes the combination of the dark blue colour of the Navy and the sky blue colour of the Indian Air Force.

SCHOOL CREST

The crest of the school is adopted from the original royal crest of the Gajapathi Dynasty which ruled Vizianagaram in the ancient past. The two portraits of elephants in the school crest are of symbolic representation of loyalty; the picture of a flower pot with Lotus is the symbol of truth and knowledge. The inscription "Sadaiwa Viswasi" is the motto of the Gajapathi dynasty and the same has been adopted by Sainik School Korukonda.

SAIKORIAN

It may be of interest to note that the word 'SAIKORIAN', the acronym given to the cadets of this school derived from the telegraphic address "SAIKOR" which is coined from the first three letters of the words 'SAINIK' and KORUKONDA'.
