  - Add diagram/map if possible.

  - Short and long-term impacts.
  - Use bullet points or flowcharts.
- Page 8 Preparedness & Management
  - Pre-disaster measures (awareness, warnings, training).
  - During disaster measures (safety steps, first aid, rescue).
  - Post-disaster measures (relief camps, rebuilding, rehabilitation).
- Page 9 Role of NDRF and Other Organisations
  - Write about NDRF (National Disaster Response Force) its formation, training, and role in rescue/relief.
  - Mention NDMA (National Disaster Management Authority), SDRF (State Disaster Response Force).
  - If disaster is international in nature, add UN bodies, Red Cross, NGOs.
  - Example:

- NDRF carried out rescue operations during the 2013 Uttarakhand floods.
