






Page 2 – Title Page

- Heading should be written as:

- Name, class, section, roll number at the bottom.
- Well decorated.

Page 3 – Acknowledgement

- Short note (5–6 lines). Example:

I thank my teacher, school, and parents for their valuable guidance and encouragement in completing this Social Science Project successfully. I also acknowledge the resources I referred to while preparing this project.

Page 4 – Index / Content Page

- Table format:

Page 5 onwards – Main Content (Check the topic)

Last Page – References (Page 12)

- Other authentic sources
